

CODE OF CONDUCT: COACHES

The purpose of this code of conduct for coaches is to establish common expectations for all members of the coaching staff. It is to be used as a guide to promote a positive team environment and good sportsmanship.

As a coach and/or volunteer of the Joliet YMCA Jets Swim Team, I will:

	At all times, adhere to USA Swimming's rules, code of conduct and MAAPP policy.
	Strive to exhibit the characteristics outlined in our Qualities of Effective Coaches document.
	Attend and be on time for all team meetings, practices and meets I am scheduled to be at.
	Set a good example of respect and sportsmanship for participants and fans to follow.
	Act and dress with professionalism and dignity, and adhere to the YMCA's uniform policy.
	Respect officials and their judgment and abide by the rules of the event.
	Treat other coaches, participants, parents and spectators with respect.
	Instruct participants in sportsmanship and demand that they display good sportsmanship.
	Coach in a positive manner and do not use derogatory comments or abusive language.
	Win with humility and lose with dignity.
	Treat every athlete fairly, justly, impartially, intelligently, and with sensitivity.
	Always place the well-being, health, and safety of swimmers above all other considerations, including developing performance.
	Continue to seek and maintain my own professional development in all areas in relation to coaching and teaching children.
	Always maintain a professional separation between coach and athlete.
Any complaints of a coach violating this code of conduct will be brought to the attention of his/her supervisor and/or a YMCA director.
